ITEM 4 - CHANGES IN REGISTRANT'S CERTIFYING ACCOUNTANT

Effective April 21, 1999, InterUnion Financial Corporation ("InterUnion" or the "Company") dismissed Ahearn Jasco + Company, P.A. ("AJC") of Pompano Beach, Florida. AJC reported on InterUnion's financial statements for its fiscal year ended March 31, 1998. Such statements contained no adverse opinion or a disclaimer of opinions, and was not qualified as to uncertainty, audit scope or accounting principles. The decision to change accountants was recommended by InterUnion's Audit Committee and approved by InterUnion's Board of Directors.

During the last two fiscal years and subsequent interim period to the date hereof, there were no disagreements between InterUnion and its certifying accountants on any matters of accounting principles or practices, financial statement disclosure, or auditing scope or procedure, which disagreements, if not resolved to satisfaction of the certifying accountants, would have caused it to make a reference to the subject matter of the disagreements in connection with its reports.

None of the reportable events described in Item 304(a) (1) (ii) occurred with respect to InterUnion within the last two fiscal years and the subsequent interim period to the date hereof.
